SUN CORALS ARE NON PHOTOSYNTHETIC

Sun Corals are non-photosynthetic and get their name from the beautiful and symmetric yellow tentacles they sprout making them look like the sun!

These corals are the coolest and one of the most popular available and the polyps, when open add a lot of color and aesthetic beauty to your aquarium.

A regular feeding schedule ensures that the polyps bloom in anticipation for their food at the same time everyday, almost like a pet. This makes them a robust and clever coral species that hold their shape.

Our Sun Corals are accustomed to eating daily around 6pm - you can use the blended recipe provided here in this video or you can use ReefRoids by PolypLabs and turkey baste them with pumps off. SunCorals prefer a thicker paste consistency when feeding due to their medium sized mouths.

HERE ARE 3 EZ TO FOLLOW STEPS:



1. Tempt them with **Polyp Booster by PolypLabs** with a light dusting with pumps off. Do this ever day at the same time for 3 consecutive days.



2. **By the third day**, the beautiful tentacles of the sun coral should be out by feeding time! Use a thin mixture of reef roid or defrosted krill as food and feed them at noon daily to **make your aquariums colorful and beautiful during the day.**



3. **Feed Daily at the same time for best growth and health.** Feeding times can be adjusted slowly to enjoy this beautiful coral on your schedule.
